

# Fentikol Vaginal Cream

## Fenticonazole Nitrate 2%

### COMPOSITION:

**Fentikol** Vaginal Cream :Each gram cream contains Fenticonazole Nitrate BP 20 mg.

### PHARMACOLOGY:

Fenticonazole is an imidazole antifungal, active against a range of organisms including dermatophyte pathogens, *Malassezia furfur* (Tinea versicolor) and *Candida albicans*.

It inhibits the production of a chemical called ergosterol, which is a component of the fungal cell membrane. Damage to this membrane cannot be repaired and this interferes with the fungal cell's ability to reproduce, hence the infection is controlled.

### INDICATION:

Treatment of Vulvovaginal candidiasis.

### DOSAGE AND APPLICATION:

Route of application: Intravaginal.

Adults: One applicator full (about 5 gm) is to be administered into the vagina in the morning and evening for three days.

Children: The use of Fenticonazole in children is not recommended.

### CONTRAINDICATION:

Contraindicated in patients with hypersensitive to Fenticonazole or any component of the formulation.

### SIDE EFFECTS:

After intravaginal administration, slight transient burning may occasionally occur, which usually disappears rapidly.

### PRECAUTIONS:

The product should not be used in conjunction with barrier contraceptives.

### USE IN PREGNANCY AND LACTATION:

Since there is no experience of use during pregnancy or lactation, So Fenticonazole should not be used without physician's advice.

### DRUG INTERACTIONS:

Not investigated. Since systemic absorption of Fenticonazole after application is low, interactions with other drugs are unlikely.

### PHARMACEUTICAL PRECAUTION:

It should be stored in a cool and dry place, protected from light and moisture.

### HOW SUPPLIED:

**Fentikol** Vaginal Cream: Each lami tube contains 30 gm of cream with applicator.
