

# LAGITA

Sodium Alginate +Potassium Bicarbonate

## COMPOSITION:

**Lagita** Suspension: Each 5 ml Suspension contains Sodium Alginate USP 500 mg and Potassium Bicarbonate USP 100 mg.

## PHARMACOLOGY:

**Lagita** belongs to a group of medicines called 'Reflux Suppressants'. Reflux is the process in which the acid juices in the stomach flow back up into the food pipe causing the pain and discomfort commonly known as heartburn. Lagita works by forming a protective layer that floats on the top of the stomach contents, preventing reflux and keeping the stomach contents away from the lining of the food pipe.

## INDICATION:

Treatment of symptoms of gastroesophageal reflux such as acid regurgitation, heartburn and indigestion (related to reflux), for example, following meals, or during pregnancy, or in patients with symptoms related to reflux esophagitis.

## DOSAGE AND ADMINISTRATION:

Daily 4 times after meals and before bedtime. **Adult and child over 12 years:** 1-2 tea spoon (5-10 ml) suspension. **Child 2-12 years:** 1/2-1 tea spoon (2.5-5 ml) suspension.

## CONTRAINDICATION:

This medicinal product is contraindicated in patients with known or suspected hypersensitivity to the active substances or to any of the excipient.

## SIDE EFFECT:

Very rarely (<1/10,000) patients may develop allergic manifestations, such as urticaria or bronchospasm, anaphylactic reactions.

## USE IN PREGNANCY AND LACTATION:

**Lagita** can be given in pregnant and lactating mother.

## DRUG INTERACTION:

Interaction with other medicinal products and other forms of interaction are unknown.

## OVERDOSAGE:

In the event of overdose symptomatic treatment should be given. The patient may notice abdominal distension.

## STORAGE:

Store in a cool and dry place (below 30°C), protected from light and moisture. Keep out of reach of children.

## PACKING:

**Lagita** Suspension: Each PET bottle contains 200 ml of suspension
