

# Anipar Vet

Piperazine Citrate

## COMPOSITION:

**Anipar Vet Powder:** Each gram powder contains Piperazine Citrate BP 1000 mg.

## PHARMACOLOGY:

**Anipar Vet** is an anthelmintic with activity against nematodes (Round worm). It closes neuromuscular transmission. As a result parasite suffers from flaccid paralysis and dies.

## INDICATIONS:

**Anipar Vet** is used in infestations produced by nematode sensitive to Piperazine eg. Ascaris, Oxyuris, Strongyloides & Trichuris of poultry, cattle, buffaloes, horse, goat, sheep and dog.

## DOSAGE & ADMINISTRATION:

2 days 250-500 mg/kg body weight or use 10 gm powder in 6-8 litter of drinking or 10 gm/3.5 kg feed for 100 chicken (4-6 weeks) or 50-60 pullet or 20-30 layers.

25-50 gm/100 kg body weight.

4-8 gm/10 kg body weight.

1-2.5 gm/10 kg body weight poultry.

or as directed by the registered veterinarian.

## SIDE EFFECTS:

**Anipar Vet** is very safe. However, emesis and softening of the feces may be reported.

## PRECAUTIONS:

Water supply should be off for 12 hours before using the drug.

## CONTRAINDICATIONS:

- Hypersensitivity to any active ingredients.
- Chronic liver or kidney insufficiency

## DRUG INTERACTION:

The sufficient clinical data is not found.

## WITHDRAWAL PERIOD :

Meat & Eggs : 2 days

Milk : Not required

## PHARMACEUTICAL PRECAUTION:

Store in a cool & dry place (below 30°C) protected from light & moisture.

Keep all medicines out of the reach of children.

**Anipar Vet Powder:** Each box contains 10 sachets of 100 gm powder.
